2 Test Distance: 40"

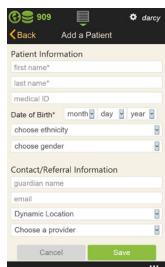

3 Orientation: Head straight, eyes directly at the camera

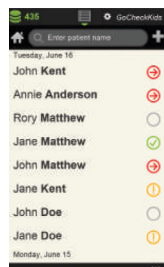


Follow the Photoscreening Steps

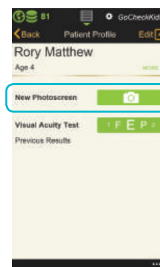
1 Enter patient on Web or phone.



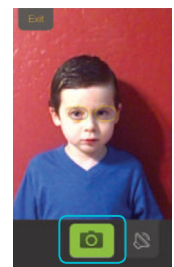
2 Select patient.



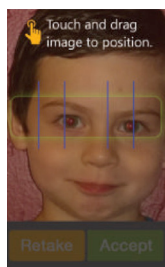
3 Select "New Photoscreen."



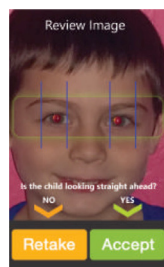
4 Align gold ovals over eyes and take photo.



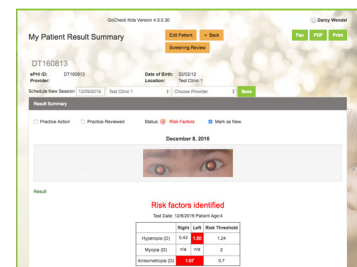
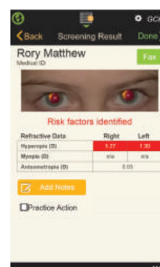
5 Touch and drag image within the blue lines/yellow box.



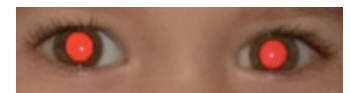
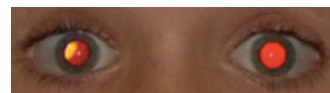
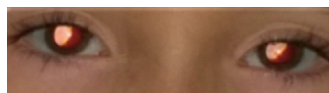
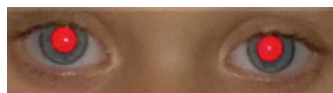
6 Review image and accept if eyes forward.



7 Review results on phone and Web. Fax, download PDF, or print result.

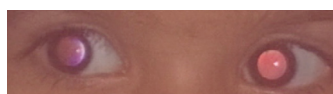


Aim for a Great Image: Head Straight, Eyes Directly at the Camera

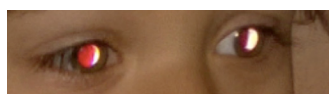


Watch for Common Mistakes

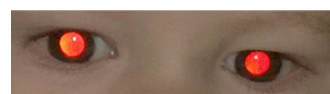
Eyes turned
